

II. MOH Measures

Those who do not wear masks during the epidemic will be fined 100 B\$; those who violate or fail to observe the "digital quarantine order" is illegal behavior and can be fined up to 5000 B\$. If prosecuted by the court, they will face a fine of up to 10,000 B\$ or imprisonment up to 6 months, or both penalties. The previous regulations enacted by government on 7 and 9 August are valid until 4 September.

The Ministry of Health of Brunei once again reminds the public to always pay attention to the color of the BruHealth code on mobile phones. There are 5 types, namely "green", "yellow", "red", "purple" and "blue". Those holding Red and Purple are not allowed to leave their home, unless to test center or treatment center. Once the Red or Purple Code holders are found to go out of their home, they may face fines or prosecutions. They can be up to 10,000 B\$ or jailed for 6 months or both.

At Aug 26th press conference, the Ministry of Health stated that the 20 virus samples previously sequenced abroad were all Delta variants. The Ministry of Health reminded the public not to panic. The previously adopted measures are still effective means of control.

III. Company Covid Prevention

1. Company publicity

1.1 Announcement of Company Covid Prevention Strategies: the latest Covid situation and the Company's regulations are updated every day in staff group chats.

1.2 Company underlies that only those holding Green or Yellow Code are allowed to go to work. Those with Red Code are forbidden to go out, including those who will arrive on 17 Sept. Fake Green Code is extremely forbidden. Fresh real-time should be showed to those who access the PMB bridge.

1.3 employees are expected to learn how to use BruHealth App, update their info on a daily basis. Avoid mistakes in updating the app.

2. Logistics supports

2.1 Office Area: routine disinfection in offices, vehicles each day going normal.

2.2 Logistics: starting from this week, staff need show BruHealth Code when they take the bus.

3. Health monitoring and medical care services

3.1 HSE Dept checks temperature and mask-up compliance everyday.

3.2 The emergency clinic on the PMB is operating normally, the Company is continuously checking on its self-enclosed management.

3.3 Wu Di and Chu Haisen have completed Drive-Through covid test, and are now in home isolation. Wu Di tested negative for 2nd time and already went to work on PMB. Chu is still waiting for result.

3.4 The HSE department has set up fixed temperature detection points at the K1 gate of the West Tank Farm and the C1 gate of the main plant area to monitor the body temperature of personnel entering the plant before 7 am and after 9 pm every day. The K1 gate of the West Tank District includes body temperature monitoring of BSM tank truck drivers, and all units are required to cooperate fully in the implementation of epidemic prevention.

4. Communications with the government

Updates COVID prevention daily reports to PA and Chinese Embassy. Today PA asked if Hengyi needed its assistance to arrange vaccine appointments for essential employees. The Human Resources Department and the HSE Management Department are currently collecting relevant information, and the statistics are expected to be completed on September 3rd. In addition, PA asked Hengyi about the lockdown management requirements, allowances, shift schedules, and concerns of employees' family members for local employees working on the island, and has responded. The Human Resources Department has sent an email to notify all local employees, reminding them of precautions during their stay in closed camps under the island.

5. Materials Assurance

Material consumption status: 420 disposable medical surgery gowns, 240 KN95 masks, 200 medical masks, 400 medical gloves, 10 goggles.

Materials currently in stock: 1327 disposable medical surgery gowns; 5345 KN95 Masks; 51730 disposable masks, 8675 medical gloves; 33 thermometers; 334 protective goggles. 71 spraying bottles (2L); 96 bottles of disinfectant sprays; 775 bottles of sanitizers; 680 gallons of big bottles of disinfectant liquids (1 gallon/bbl); 84 bottles of disinfectant liquids (3L).

6. Contractor Management During the COVID-19 Pandemic

A total of 210 ppl have temperature checks 2 times every day. Living areas disinfected everyday.
