

Significance of Hari Raya with HYBN Firefighters

Celebrating Hari Raya Aidilfitri

Pulau Muara Besar, May 2nd 2022 – Today marks the first day where the firefighters in Hengyi comes together to have a momentous celebration of Hari Raya Aidilfitri. Hari Raya Puasa, or the festival of Eid (*Eid al-Fitr*), marks the end of the fasting month of Ramadan for all Muslims and with that it embarks on a new month of the Islamic calendar, Syawal. Hari Raya is a celebration of victory in completing the fast and overcoming the personal struggles during the Ramadan month, as well as a time for forgiveness and strengthening of bonds with family members, relatives and friends.

To bring out the festive mood of this joyous occasion, the celebration was carried out through the course of two days as it also serves the purpose of enhancing the bonding and relationship between HYBN's employees: firefighters, dispatchers, PMC, together with the Management. HYBN firefighters have rallied together in arrangement and decoration of the room venue and having gift bags for the event. They have achieved their aim in making the day to be festive while capturing everyone's attention with the theme '*Raya in Caribbean*'.
